To Whom It May Concern:


As in the past, the West Virginia Department of Transportation (WVDOT) is required to consult with non-metropolitan local officials (with jurisdiction/responsibility for transportation) in transportation planning and programming decisions. Due to the high percentage of state controlled highways in West Virginia, coupled with the fact that few local units of government have jurisdiction over highways and bridges in the state, the WVDOT will utilize the Regional Planning and Development Councils (RPDC) as the vehicle to coordinate and provide the opportunity for local consultation. The Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration have endorsed this process.

To that end, the WVDOT is submitting the most recent proposed Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment to your region for local review and comment. In addition, and in the spirit and intent of SAFETEA-LU, the WVDOT hereby provides the aforementioned local officials with the opportunity to consult with Departmental officials on the contents of the attached modified listing of STIP amendments. All written comments and the opportunity for local consultation will extend through September 7, 2010.
